## **CHANGES TO THE ACCREDITED PROGRAM**

Within the above mentioned cause of concern, the program reports that the continued strength in enrollment of students has resulted in a presidential decision to reopen the old architecture building and a new addition to it of \$4.9 million. The addition will approximately provide 14,000 sq. ft of additional studio, office and lecture space. This will provide much needed accommodation for the Design Foundation Program beginning in the fall 2010 semester.
