- All Architecture Core courses must be passed successfully with a grade of C or higher to be applied to graduation
- ARCH 3313 ETech II & ARCH 3211 Structures II should be taken concurrently with ARCH 3011 Studio
- ARCH 3314 ETech III & ARCH 3212 Structures III should be taken concurrently with ARCH 3012 Studio
- All courses must be passed with a letter grade of 'C' or higher to be counted toward graduation and to fulfill prerequisite requirements.
- All Students should follow the course flow chart as closely as possible. Students who fall out of sequence are encouraged to take courses in the summer to get back on track.
- The Course Flow Chart has 17 credits appointed to Elective/Minor. Students may elect to use these credits for free electives or take a minor in another field. Should the minor be less than the allotted 17 credits the student should apply the extra credit toward a free elective.
