# Scholarship and Awards Opportunities

Once you have been accepted to KSU, you can begin using **Scholarship Universe** to search and apply for scholarships.

- **Current KSU students, log in to ScholarshipUniverse with your NetID and password.**
- **Select the Questions tab to the left and begin answering questions about yourself and your academic plans.**
- **Click the Scholarships tab on the left side of the screen to view scholarships whose eligibility requirements you meet.**
- **Filter your display by amount, application end date or scholarship type.**
- **View or Apply for any scholarships displayed in your Matched section.**
- **You can also search for a specific scholarship by name if you do not see it in your Matched section.**

**Once your desired scholarship is located, be sure you answer all related questions.**

- **Upload your resume and essay. Most scholarships do not require letters of recommendation; however, if letters of recommendation are requested on your application, you will see this clearly stated in ScholarshipUniverse. Through ScholarshipUniverse, you will send an invitation to individuals requesting they write your two recommendation letters.**
- **Review and submit your application. Please note, you are able to answer additional questions to match to additional scholarships after submitting your initial application. The more questions you answer, the more scholarship matches you may receive.**

- Scholarship is renewable through with application (re-apply the next year)
- Students should actively participate in campus organizations and/or competition teams

### Application Requirements

- Portfolio | Creative work: Exemplary design work and demonstration of skills in multiple medias (models, drawings and digital)
- List of Activities: Leadership | Engagement | Volunteering
- Reference: Two in support of “Activities” category
- Presentation: who you are, one exemplary design project and examples of engagement.

**Evaluation:** 70% Studio Work | 30% Engagement Activities

## Jimmy Goldgeier

- Applicants in their **3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> Year** -- 4th and 5th year at the time of AWARD
- Renewable until graduation for full-time students
- Full-time student
- Preference given to **transfer students**
- **70<sup>th</sup> to 90<sup>th</sup> (2.8 -3.6 GPA)** percentile in the Architecture Program
- Rankings based on cumulative GPA at the time of application

### Application Requirements:

- List of achievements
- Answer Questions about your creativity and why would you be a Goldgeier scholar
- An essay of 500 word count max

# Travel Scholarships

## **The Kimball Family Endowed Scholarship**

Provide financial support to deserving students, majoring in Architecture, to assist with travel expenses for international study abroad or domestic study programs.

- Majoring in Architecture
- Must hold a minimum overall 2,5 GPA
- Must be a full-time student
- At time of application, must be a 3rd or 4th year Architecture student

## **The Rizzuto Family Endowed Scholarship**

Provide financial support to deserving students, majoring in Architecture, to assist with travel expenses for international study abroad or domestic study programs.

- Majoring in Architecture
- Must hold a minimum overall 2.5 GPA
- Must be a full-time student
- At time of application, must be junior or senior Architecture student

# KSU Scholarship

## Safe Space Scholarship

- . Full or Part Time Students
- . Applicant must demonstrate a track record of advocacy for LGBT individuals or involvement in LGBT organizations within the community or the community at large
- . Open to all majors
- . Undergraduate students: must be registered for a minimum of 6 credit hours per term, must have completed a minimum of 30 credit hours at KSU with a minimum 3.0 GPA
- . Graduate students: must be registered for a minimum of 6 credit hours per term, enrolled in any graduate degree program, and must have completed a minimum of 9 credit hours at KSU with a minimum 3.3 GPA.
- . Recipients are to be selected by a designated committee and will receive up to \$1000 per academic year.

Application Due Date: **March 1<sup>st</sup> 2022, KSU website.**

- Submitted to the Scholarship Committee through D2L
- D2L folder access will be granted after student's request

**Application Requirements: All as a package in “1 PDF FILE”**

- (a) Cover page form (*available through D2L – Scholarship Committee*)
- (b) a one-or-two-page curriculum vitae for each nominee stating, among other things, name, contact information, progress in studies, and anticipated degree and date of graduation;
- (c) a maximum 1,000-word essay written by the nominee describing their goals and aspirations, both educationally and professionally;
- (d) a limited graphic portfolio of the nominee’s work (**five to ten 8.5 x 11-inch pages representing the student’s work**)
- (e) provide a list of past scholarships and awards received by the nominee as well as those the nominee is currently applying for.

The selected applicants will be provided with a letter of recommendation from the chair of the Department of Architecture.

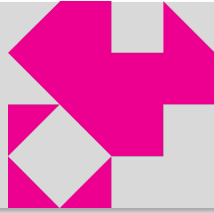

### Eligibility Criteria:

- For KSU Architecture Students Only
- Applicants must be rising 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> or 4<sup>th</sup> year by Summer 2022
- Candidates must be continuing their studies in the following year.
- Must be a **minority student**, preference given to students who demonstrate financial need or are first generation college students

### Application Requirements

- 500-word essay describing a particularly satisfying project you've undertaken, need not be architectural design or planning (but this is preferable)
- Resume showing GPA; Leadership & Volunteering Activities; Honors; Awards, (note whether an office held was elected or appointed); Professional Societies; Publications; Avocations; Hobbies; Travel.
- Transcripts

# **Tom Cory Scholarship by American Precast Association**

## **National Scholarship**

### **Eligibility**

1. Cumulative G.P.A. of 3.0 or higher. Must maintain a 3.0 G.P.A. during scholarship period.
2. Must continue education in pursuit of an architectural degree.
3. Must have at least two semesters of school left to complete from date of award. Both Undergraduate and Graduate levels are acceptable. 3rd and 4th year
4. Must be involved in activities related to the architectural field.

### **Application Requirement**

1. Scholarship Application.
2. A transcript of two years college through the last grading period prior to the date of application.
3. A typed description of your career plans after graduation.
4. A typed essay (essay 1) explaining why you chose this career.
5. A typed essay (essay 2) of 300 – 500 words on a topic of your choice related to the precast concrete industry.
6. A letter of recommendation from a faculty member of your College or University.

- \$2000

# Point Foundation: The National LGBT Scholarship Fund

## Eligibility

1. A proven track record of leadership and community involvement
2. Strong academic achievement
3. Working for the betterment of the LGBTQ community
4. Financial need

## Application Requirement

1. Must be enrolled or intending to enroll at an accredited college or university based in the United States, including Hawaii and Alaska, in the fall of 2022.
2. Students enrolled or intending to enroll in a college or university in a United States territory are NOT eligible.
3. Must be “out” as a person who identifies as a member of the LGBTQ community.
4. Must be enrolled full-time for the full academic year.
5. Must be enrolled in a degree-granting undergraduate or graduate/ doctoral program. Post-doctoral research programs are not eligible.
6. If selected as a finalist, the finalist must be able to record a video for the Point Selections Committee. More details provided to those who reach the finalist stage.

## Award

Each person who applies for a Point Scholarship is evaluated on the totality of their situation.

**Timeline: November 1, 2021** Point’s Scholarship Application opens online.

**EXTENDED January 24, 2022:** Point’s Scholarship Application closes at 9:00 AM PST/12:00 PM EST.
